Fight Cancer Foundation was formed in 1989 as the Bone Marrow Donor Institute to establish a bone marrow donor register to give leukaemia and cancer patients a second chance of life.

Fight Cancer Foundation has developed projects with a wide capacity of community impact giving cancer patients and their families the opportunity for a second chance of life.

**Accommodation Centres for Patients and Carers**  
Fight Cancer Foundation has responded to cancer patients and their families in need of affordable accommodation close to major treating hospitals. We have established accommodation centres in Melbourne, Hobart and Albury.

**Life Saving Research**  
Vital research is being undertaken in collaboration with The Royal Melbourne Hospital into cancer treatments and cures.

**Education Support for Children and Teens**  
Fight Cancer Foundation funds education support to assist students while they are away from school during treatment and recovery.

**BMDI Cord Blood Bank**  
People with leukaemia or other blood cancers can be offered a second chance of life with a cord blood transplant. This vital community health project was developed to provide an alternative treatment for patients needing a bone marrow transplant unable to find a match with a suitable donor.

**Australian Bone Marrow Donor Registry**  
This was the first major project for Fight Cancer Foundation and was established in direct response to a community need. Today, 175,000 Australians are registered and the Registry is linked to an international database of 10 million potential donors.

# John Opie House

John Opie House, an initiative of Fight Cancer Foundation, benefits the Tasmanian community by providing comfortable and affordable accommodation for patients and carers during medical treatment.

Having a loved one nearby is a critical aspect of recovery and treatment. Finding suitable accommodation can be difficult and at times costly. John Opie house offers families in need a home away from home, alleviating financial stress and worry.

Housed in an historic building (1850) and only a five minute walk to the Royal Hobart Hospital, John Opie House can accommodate up to 24 patients and their carers each night.

## FACILITIES

John Opie House has 15 well appointed bedrooms, and a welcoming and well equipped Family Room that can comfortably accommodate up to five guests per night.

The House has a large communal kitchen, bathrooms and laundry facilities and a warm office for guests to use. The two communal lounge areas include Plasma TVs with DVD players and are designed to be warm and welcoming to guests of all ages.

The Guest Office has a computer with internet access, and the building has free Wi-Fi so guests can stay in touch with family, friends and the outside world.

## COST

The standard room rate is \$56 per night. If the patient/carer qualifies for government travel assistance (PTAS)\* then the room rate is \$10.

\*An approval from PTAS is required to receive this nightly rate

## SAFETY AND SECURITY

John Opie House is equipped with smoke detectors, fire extinguishers and the alarm system is directly linked to the Fire Brigade. The House is patrolled regularly by security during evenings and weekends.
